


EN UNIQUE AND VERSATILE, UNLIKE TRADITIONAL BATH STEPS WITH ONE OR TWO FIXED HEIGHTS, THE LANGHAM K40 BATH STEP IS MODULAR ; ALLOWING EXTRA SECTIONS TO BE ADDED OR REMOVED AS REQUIRED. SUPPLIED WITH 4 SECTIONS TO GIVE A BASIC STEP OF 100MM (4"), EXTRA SECTIONS CAN BE PURCHASED TO FURTHER BUILD THE STEP UP. EACH SECTION IS SLIGHTLY TEXTURED TO GIVE A NON-SLIP SURFACE WITHOUT BEING UNCOMFORTABLE ON THE FEET.


- 1. ENSURE THE STEP IS DRY AND FREE FROM SOAP OR OIL FILM.
- 2. ENSURE THE RUBBER FEET ARE IN PLACE ON THE BOTTOM STEP SECTION.
- 2. ENSURE THE ROBBLE THE SIDE OF THE BATH IN THE ORIENTATION SHOWN.
 3. FOSITION THE STEP UP TO THE SIDE OF THE BATH IN THE ORIENTATION SHOWN.
 4. THE HEIGHT OF THE STEP SHOULD BE THE SAME AS THE INSIDE BASE OF THE BATH IN ORDER TO REDUCE OVER BALANCING.
 4.1 ADDING SECTIONS INSERT THE LOCATOR PINS INTO THE CORRESPONDING HOLES. ENSURE ALL SECTIONS ARE FIRMLY TOGETHER BEFORE USE. 4.2 REMOVING SECTIONS - EASE APART EACH CORNER USING A BLUNT EDGE TOOL. ENSURE ANY REMAINING SECTIONS ARE FIRMLY TOGETHER BEFORE


USE 5. TEST FOR STABILITY.


6. STAND CENTRALLY ONTO THE STEP WITH BOTH FEET BEFORE STEPPING INTO THE BATH.
